

The CIPS on the Castingsport Congress

The CIPS was invited to the Congress and General Assembly of the International Casting Sport Federation, hold in Berlin 23-25 October 2015. The Confederation was represented by Ferenc Szalay, President of CIPS. This representation was a special significance, because – as Kurt Klamet, the ICSF President has underlined in his report – it was the first time when a CIPS President participated on an ICSF Congress.

“Both we are members of the same family: the family of the sport fishing” – said the President of the CIPS. “So, we are responsible not only for the present but also for the future of the sport fishing. Consequently we have to promote our sport especially among young people; we have to involve more and more people, especially the most possible young ones to the sport fishing.”

This time it was an elective ICSF congress. After the reports of the Presidium and modification of the Statutes and the Internal Rules (especially for the reason of the Olympic recognition), the delegates voted for Kurt Klamet as President and Josef Dolezal as General Secretary of the casting international. Mr. Szalay was elected member of the ICSF Ethical Commission.

For confirming the cooperation between the CIPS and the ICSF, the two presidents have signed a Declaration on Cooperation.
