

Cooperation CIPS-EFSA

At the headquarter in Rome, on April 22 2017, the President of the CIPS, Mr. Ferenc Szalay and the President of the European Federation of Sea Anglers, Mr. Horst Schneider – in the presence of the FIPSAS President Mr. Claudio Matteoli and the FIPS-Mer Delegated General Secretary, Mr. Gilbert Zangerle on behalf of the CIPS and the Italian EFSA representative Mr. Massimo Brogna, and the EFSA General Secretary Mr. Marcus Wuest – have signed the Memorandum of Understanding between the two organization.

I am deeply convinced – said the President of the CIPS – that the future of the sport fishing, of the angling in largest sense, needs the cooperation between all international federations of fishing. So we have to do everything possible for this cooperation and I am aware this Memorandum is an important step following this way.
