- **I undertake** to take appropriate measures to reduce the risk of COVID-19 contagion in accordance with the health recommendations of which I am aware. For an event taking place inside a sport location, I hereby **authorize** officials to measure my body temperature every time I enter the location, for the purpose of preventing COVID-19 contagion.
- **I also declare** that I have read and will follow the Covid protocol for the conduct of CIPS and of the International Federations FIPS.

The undersigned also declares that he/she is participating in the activity as an Athlete, Captain and/or delegate in a spontaneous and voluntary manner and therefore releases the CIPS/FIPS and the Organising Committee, its employees, collaborators or appointees from any liability for any case of Covid-19 infection that may occur as a result of participation in the competitive activity.
