

44th CIPS CONGRESS 2023 - ROME - ITALY - 27/30 APRIL 2023

HOST CITY ROME

Possis nihil Urbe Roma visere maius

According to the tradition, Rome was founded on April 21st 753 b.c. by Romulus.

Today Rome is the most populous and largest city in Italy, it is the center of the Italian national and politic life and the center of Catholic religion.

Symbols of Rome, beside the municipal coat-of-arms, are the Capitoline Wolf, a bronze sculpture of a shewolf suckling twin infants Romulus and Remo; the Coliseum, the largest Amphitheatre of the Roman world that was recognized in 2007 as one of the 7 wonders of the modern world (the only one in Europe); the *Cupolone*, the big dome of Saint Peter's Basilica in Vatican City, which dominates the full city and represents the Christian World.

The religious architectures of Rome are an essential element of the Capitoline city's monumental heritage: they are the symbol of the cultural, social and artistic importance of the religious side of the full history of Rome.

There are four patriarchal Basilicas in Rome: "San Giovanni in Laterano", "San Pietro", "San Paolo fuori le mura" and "Santa Maria Maggiore".

Moreover, Rome is rich in fountains and aqueducts: among its monumental fountains, most of which were built by Popes at the beginning of the modern age, there are the Trevis' fountain, Acqua Felice's fountain (or Mosé), the Quattro Fontane, the Barcaccia's fountain, Quattro Fiumi's fountain.

TRANSPORT

By flight:

From your country, you must join the international airport Airport of Rome, Leonardo da Vinci or the international airport of Ciampino where you will be picked up by the organizing committee to go to Rome (free transport).

By car:

If you prefer to use your own vehicle, you will have to travel by road in the following directions:

Coming from Genova, get the A12 highway towards Rome, up to Rosignano Marittimo. Go on the SS Aurelia freeway towards Rome. In Civitavecchia, get the highway towards Rome. Once arrived at the junction, before getting the toll, keep right and then any directional marks towards Rome – Firenze. Get then the Grande Raccordo Anulare (GRA), direction A1 Firenze. Then take the exit n. 6 towards the city center, in via Flaminia Nuova for about 4 km. Continue for about 7 km and then turn right into Via di Vigna Stelluti as far as Piazza dei Giuochi Delfici. Go onto the roundabout, then take the second exit on the right; Via della Camilluccia. The hotel is located at about 700 m.

Coming from Milan, get the A1 highway, up to the highway central junction in Bologna; continue on the A1 highway towards Rome. Once arrived at the junction, before getting the toll, take the right and then any directional marks towards Rome. Get then the Grande Raccordo Anulare (GRA), direction Civitavecchia – Airport Fiumicino. Then take the exit n. 6 (Via Flaminia) towards the city center, in via Flaminia Nuova for about 4 km.

Continue for about 7 km and then turn right into Via di Vigna Stelluti as far as Piazza dei Giuochi Delfici. Go onto the roundabout, then take the second exit on the right; Via della Camilluccia. The hotel is located at about 700 m.
