Comments :

- Pierre **KUNTZ** from France is first ever athlete to become triple consecutive world champion. FIPS-Mouche decided to allow to keep the individual trophy.
- Organisations of opening and closing ceremonies need to be as public event as possible. We have included into the scenario protocol for the opening ceremony the playing of the CIPS anthem.
- Ladies' world championship was disrupted due to the organisers (USA) obligation of signing a liability waiver by the athletes. This resulted in the Australian Ladies not taking part in the championship.

- Anti-doping: test were done during the Senior event in Czech Republic. All results were negative.

To our knowledge Macedonia has been a long-time member of FIPS-ed. We look forward to welcoming Macedonia as a new FIPS-Mouche member. We will communicate with them so they may participate in the 2026 championship.

We have contacted possible new members and hope and strive to enlarge our community in coming years.

General information

We used for the first time in 2026 the recently finalised online draw and resulting program (web application).

Our website changed to <https://fips-mouche.cips-fips.com/> as agreed at CIPS level. We have used our website for online registration of teams. The SPOC for each FIPS-Mouche member has the authorisation credentials for maintaining their athletes, captains, managers, ... etc. via the FIPS-Mouche website.

We are further taking step to integrate data from our website (athletes' data) with the online draw and resulting program.

Finances

In 2025 our expenses exceeded our income with approximately 10.000 euro. This is due to a final invoice for the web application online draw and resulting, travel cost to championships in USA for FIPS-Mouche personnel (board and international supervisors), inspection in RSA for LWFFC in 2027 as part of the World Games. Also the CIPS congress weighs heavily on the finances.
